


STEP 1 - Mark Pilot Holes

Mark and drill 6 pilot holes on each cabinet side for runners and lid brackets.



STEP 2 - Prepare the Runners


Lift the locking levers and remove the front part of each runner. Ensure the shoulder faces outward.






STEP 3 - Install Lid Brackets and Runners


Attach lid brackets (D/E) and runners (F/G) to the cabinet sides using screws A.



STEP 4 - Mount Brackets to Door

Mark screw points using the provided diagram. Attach door brackets using screws B.









STEP 5 - Reattach the Runners

Slide the front runner sections back in until the locking levers click securely into place.



STEP 6 - Mount the Frame


Place the metal frame (I) on top of the mounted runners and secure it using screws C.






STEP 7 - Attach the Lid

Install the lid (H) by sliding it into the lid brackets. It should snap or click into place.



STEP 8 - Align the Door

Use the adjustment screws on the brackets to align the door flush with the cabinet face.





STEP 8 - Align the Door

Place the ironing board assembly in the center of the cabinet, ensuring it is set 15 mm back from the front edge.
